Description of Saddle Peak Avalanche:

1-2' deep storm <u>slab</u> released on the Main Face of North Saddle about 100' from the ridge. The skier triggered the <u>slide</u> just uphill of the first cliff band. The avalanche propagated 200' wide and ran over the cliffs to the bottom of Going Home Chute. The skier then climbed out and descended a different route.
