"Crown was 4-6" deep, approximately 30' across (just shy of the width of the <u>couloir</u>). Ran the length of the <u>couloir</u> (~700'). Layer that slid consisted of new, unconsolidated snow. The <u>slide</u> was skier-triggered, skier stayed on his feet as it ran by them. We dug a pit beforehand on a similar <u>aspect</u> and got ECTPN. New snow concerns matched that of the forecast for today."
